Regensburg emphasizes sustainability - events and tourist offers that distinguish themselves are marked with:

TRAVEL WITH A CLEAR CONSCIENCE

What's important to us

Regensburg emphasizes sustainability.

The social aspect of sustainability is also important to us.

More and more people are choosing their travel destination according to sustainability criteria. In Regensburg, this starts with the very fabric of the buildings. The city keeps buildings in use for centuries and reduces gray energy to a minimum. Former chapels became stores or restaurants. Medieval residential towers are hotels today.

Regensburg's event spaces are located behind historic walls. This is also true beyond the Old Town. The Old Slaughterhouse in the eastern part of the city is a modern conference center with a distinctive ceiling construction. Wood was conserved for the "Zollinger ceiling" as early as the 1920s. Despite strict monument preservation requirements, the marinaforum saves energy and uses electricity from ecological sources.

REGIONAL, FAIR, AND SOCIAL

In Regensburg tourism, ecological aspects of sustainability are coupled with social ones. Hotels and restaurants avoid waste, plastic packaging, and unnecessary washing and favor local products. The inclusive hotel Includio is completely barrier-free. And the bars and eateries in the cathedral city are meeting places for everyone – tourists and Regensburg residents.

The city is easily accessible by train from all directions and is connected to the long-distance bus network. Nevertheless, tourism is not possible entirely without CO₂ emissions. Regensburg Tourismus GmbH donates money every year to offset CO₂ emissions resulting from business travel and is constantly striving to operate in a manner that is as ecologically and socially responsible as possible. It has already received numerous awards for this.

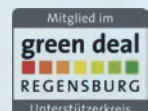

GENESIS II – THE CREATION CONTINUES

"Life comes into being around us every day – and the creation never ends"

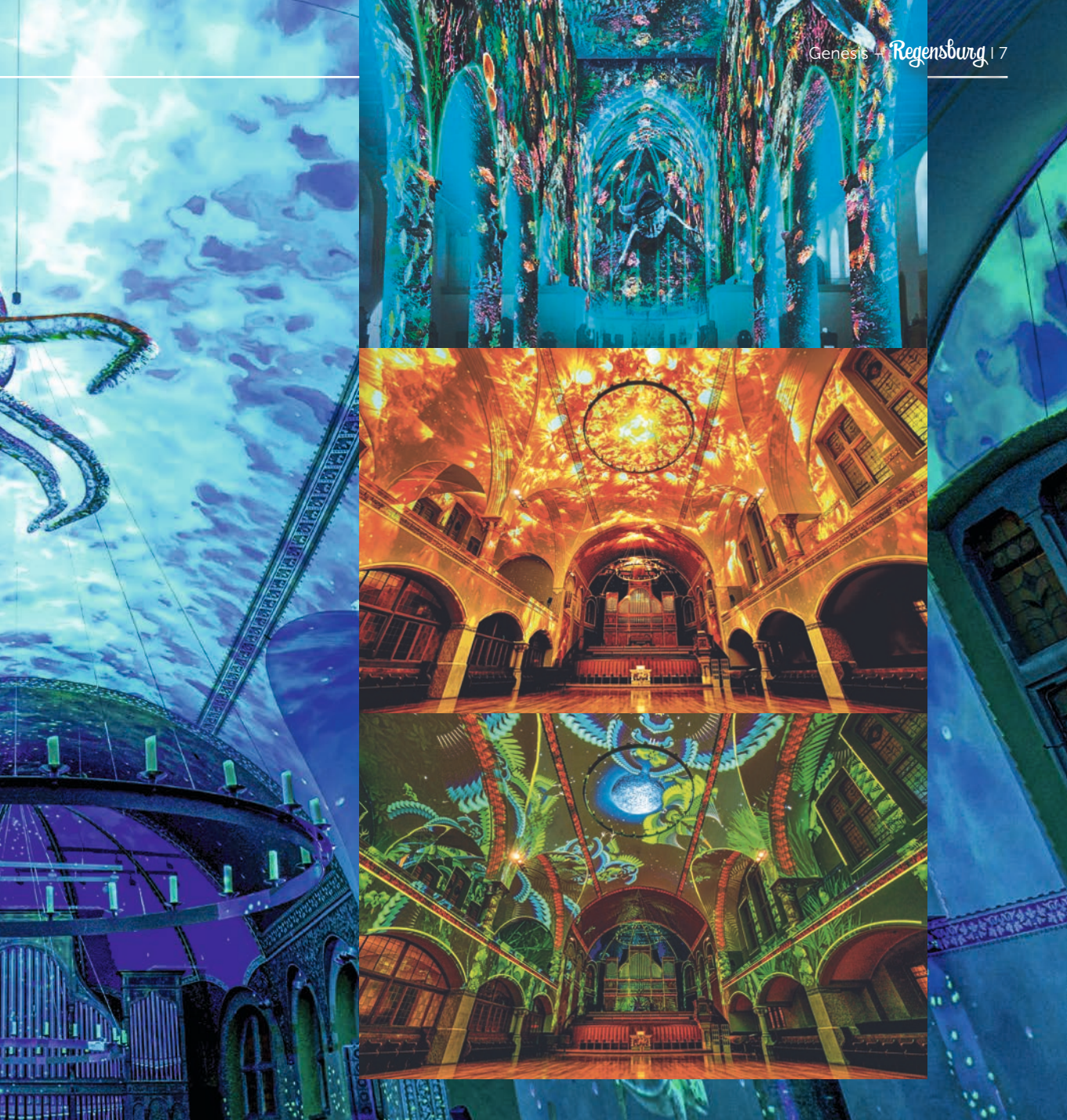
After the overwhelming success of Genesis I last winter, Kulturoptimisten and Projekt1l Zürich tell the second part of the creation story. The immersive light and video installation Genesis II uses music and impressive animations to conjure the story of the fourth to seventh days of creation on the walls and ceiling of the Minorites Church of St. Salvator on Dachauplatz.

On beanbags, couch cushions, or chairs, enveloped by light and music, you will travel to the center of the universe and witness the stars being attached to the firmament.

You will dive down to the bottom of the seas where colorful shoals of fish cavort in the coral reef and majestic whales roll overhead, visit the jungle with its diverse biome, and witness the creation of man. And the architectural features of the church, such as columns, window arches, and arcades frequently come to the fore, traced with millimeter precision and artfully staged.

The International Jazz Festival at the Regensburg Theater. Jazz is life and a wonderful adventure: you never know what's next!



January, otherwise a rather quiet month, will be characterized by world-class jazz once again in 2024. The international jazz festival Sparks & Visions will provide the first musical highlight in the special ambience of the Theater on Bismarckplatz, from January 19–21, 2024.

The three-day program boasts an impressive line-up of bands from the international jazz scene: eight bands, consisting of world-class musicians from various European countries, will once again create a diverse musical panorama and define new listening horizons.

In 2023, organizer Anastasia Wolkenstein, in cooperation with Regensburg Theater, inaugurated a scene classed in the top artistic league, attracting a great deal of national and international media attention. Besides Kamaal Williams – a key protagonist of London New Jazz – other artists who performed and delighted audiences and the attending press include Finnish saxophonist Linda Fredriksson, Albanian singer Elina Duni, and the new Benjamin Lackner Quartet with trumpeter Mathias Eick and Peter Gabriel's former drummer Manu Katché.



Music fans will be offered a world-class program again in 2024, with one or two new discoveries. A performance from the grande dame of European jazz singing, Norma Winstone, in a duo with young award-winning English pianist Kit Downes, is just one of the program features, each of which stands out in its own right, showcasing one of the many aspects of jazz. After all, jazz draws on a wide variety of influences and can include timbres from pop, rock, classical, world music, and avant garde. The exquisite 200-year-old three-tiered theater provides the perfect visual and acoustic backdrop for this dazzling, high-profile festival. We look for-

ward to more great jazz in a unique atmosphere!

A curator of two jazz festivals, artists' agent, and on the jury of the German Jazz Award, among others, Wolkenstein believes that live concerts are unparalleled in their capacity to inspire and connect people. She believes that jazz in particular is capable of surprising and stirring emotions! .

CITY WALKS

SUN AND SNOW


What a pretty picture when the fog lifts and the pond in the city park reflects the wintry landscape.




Regensburg is an ideal city for pedestrians – at any time, even in winter when the snow on the frozen ground crunches under warmly lined boots. The sun is so low in the sky that it winks right in your face. This is healthy and spreads good cheer.

From Regensburg's Old Town, it's just a stone's throw out into nature. The walkways along the Danube or the cleared graveled paths in the parks surrounding the Old Town are enticing. Regensburg owes these to Prince Karl Anselm of Thurn and Taxis. In 1779, he had an avenue laid out for strolling along the foundation walls of the former city fortifications.


If you feel like a longer tour, you can walk over the Old Stone Bridge through Stadtamhof, across the Rhine-Main-Danube Canal and up to the Dreifaltigkeitsberg or the Winzerer Höhen. Because the trees have lost their leaves, the view of the city from these lofty heights is doubly rewarding.




The Dreifaltigkeitsberg provides arguably the most beautiful view of the city on foot – even in winter.

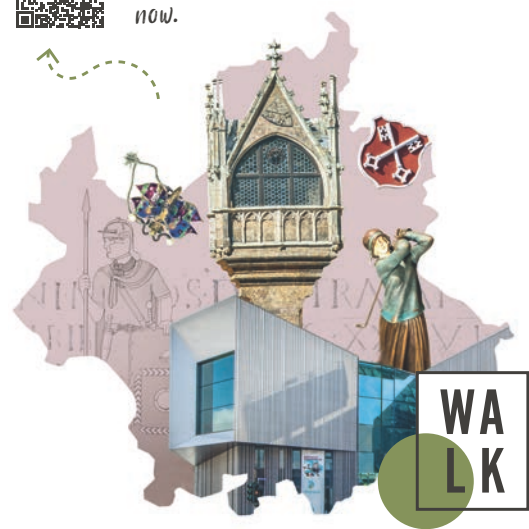

Regensburg is an El Dorado for museum lovers. From city history to art and science, large comprehensive museums or special small exhibitions and curiosities, Regensburg's treasures are on display in its museums. Modern exhibition concepts and interactive methods enable visitors to conceive of the city as a place of learning. The "document Reichstag", right next to Tourist Information on Rathausplatz, is a good starting point.



HIGHLIGHTS WALK

WHAT YOU ABSOLUTELY MUST SEE

For almost 150 years, Regensburg was the epicenter of Europe. The Perpetual Diet met here. Emperors, kings, envoys, and ministers would come in and out of the "Reichssaal" (Imperial Hall) every day. What began as a Roman military camp 2000 years ago became the Manhattan of the Middle Ages. Long-distance trade on the Danube saw the city grow flush with immense wealth.

"Medieval skyscrapers" started shooting up one after another. Regensburg boomed and transformed into a "mega city". And it also enjoyed a bit of good luck, for its Old Town was spared the World War bombings. As such, visitors can today enjoy Germany's best-preserved medieval metropolis, with the thousands of highlights that it offers. 16 of them are showcased in this brochure.

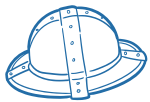

An entire state turned inside out in the space
of one lifetime!

Since 1945, construction measures and major projects have been changing the state and the landscape of Bavaria at a breathtaking pace. From the Rhine-Main-Danube Canal to the Isental highway, from the Franconian Lake District to the airport in the Erdinger Moos, from the Gundremmingen nuclear power plant to the Zugspitzplatt: the Free State resembles a gigantic and permanent construction site. While some people rejoice in mobility, energy, and growth, others despair at land consumption, the destruction of nature, and habitat loss.

The exhibition on the first floor of the Haus der Bayerischen Geschichte on Donaumarkt in Regensburg presents a selection of major Bavarian projects and the disputes surrounding them, in a staged construction site. The centerpiece is a space-defining media installation that uses large-scale projections to turn the exhibition into a movie theater and illuminate the transformation of Bavaria from 1945 to the present day.

First mentioned in 1686, Café Prinzess on Regensburg's Rathausplatz is the oldest in Germany. It owes a lot to the discerning tastes of the envoys to the Perpetual Diet. But before coffee found its adherents in this country, there was a wealthy clientèle who coveted finely crafted chocolate. The chocolate specialists from Rathausplatz supplied the Perpetual Diet. Today, the former supplier to the princely court offers chocolates with names like "Kesse Gloria" and "Toller Römer", and a cake called "Barbara Blomberg".

ENJOY TWO REGEN

Knackersemmel with everything

MUSTARD



It's hard to imagine a knackersemmel without sweet and spicy mustard. We recommend it to all travelers who are in danger of going astray. "Take it or leave it" – is what imperious men and women behind the sausage grill might be heard to say.



PICKLED

Sliced pickles belong in a knackersemmel. The faintly sweet aftertaste makes the knackersemmel perfect.



SEMME

Crisp on the outside with a fine, golden crust, soft and fluffy on the inside – these are the basic requirements for a bread roll to be revered as a knackersemmel.



HORSERADISH

Horseradish (*Armoracia rusticana*) belongs to the cruciferous family (Brassicaceae) – here it's called "kren". It has to be nice and spicy, and it may even burn a little on the palate – then the mixture is right.

KNACKWURST



... is the name of this exceptionally delicious taste virtuoso sausage creation. It's only called that in and around Regensburg. In the rest of the German-speaking world, the knacker is called "Regensburger". In any case, the people of Regensburg find knackers scrumptious.

9AM. – 4PM DAILY
AT NEUPFARRPLATZ

Around noon, the Reisinger Wurstbraterei (sausage grill) at the base of the Neupfarrkirche exudes a beguiling aroma. Like magic, it attracts people of all ages. Knowing what to expect, they're happy to stand in line for this delicacy even in winter. Get in line and simply order a "Regensburger-Semmel with everything". Then someone will hand you a steaming delicacy with horseradish, sweet mustard, and pickled gherkins from the slightly elevated sausage grill. Probably Petra Reisinger herself. Petra and Wilhelm are fourth generation "Würschtl-wender", and they know why they do it: "Aus Liebe zur Tradition und weil's mir erfunden ham! Weil's ned wurscht is, wos'd fia a Wurscht isst!" ("For the love of tradition and because I invented it! Because you should care what kind of wurst you eat!")



REGENSBURG ORIGINALS!



Bratwurstkipferl with sauerkraut

MUSTARD



It has to be sweet – but it should also have a slight spiciness! Only then does it go perfectly with the bratwurst. This special Wurstkuchl mustard comes from our own artisan production according to an secret ancient recipe and is made from many regional ingredients. A revelation!

BRATWÜRSTL



Only the best is good enough for these Rost-Bratwürstl! Only the finest parts of pigs from the region are used in these sausages, which are produced fresh six days a week in the on-site butchery, naturally without additives! Then the bratwürstl are grilled over open fire and go from there directly into your hand!

Tip: it's always best to order two kipferl at once. This saves waiting in line for the second one because the first one tasted so good.

KIPFERL

The "Schwarzer Kipferl" is a Regensburg favorite – a hand-shaped Regensburg original from one of the last Regensburg Old Town bakeries, the Bäckerei Schwarzer. Caraway and rye give it its unique flavor. Baked according to a secret recipe that has stayed the same since 1895.

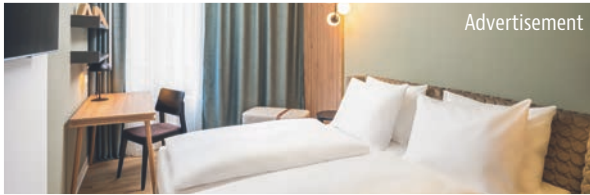
SAUERKRAUT



The best white cabbage comes from Winzer near Regensburg. It's grown there by vegetable farmer Christian Graf. After harvesting, each head of cabbage is individually inspected and cleaned by hand. With the addition of salt and juniper berries, it is then fermented into sauerkraut. No additives are used either. The journey from the field to the plate is a whole four kilometers. In our opinion, this is how regionality works – and has been doing so for centuries!

On the banks of the swirling Danube right next to the Old Stone Bridge, the Historische Wurstkuchl (historic sausage kitchen) has stood for over 500 years. Medieval Regensburg stonemasons and harbor workers fortified themselves here, and much has remained the same to this day: the open charcoal grill, the homemade sausages made of pure hind ham from the pig, the sauerkraut from the on-site fermenting cellar, and the well-known Wurstkuchl mustard made according to Elsa Schrickler's historic recipe. Daily at Thundorferstraße 3, closed on 25 and 26 December.

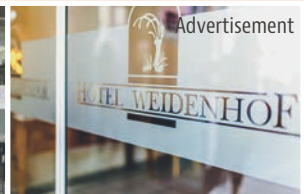
