The many festivals held at the medieval squares and arcade-lined courtyards are not just musical highlights; they're also a feast for the eyes.

OLD TOWN HALL



The Altes Rathaus (Old Town Hall) has been Regensburg's beating political heart for centuries. A building whose imposing town-hall tower was designed to symbolize the status of the Free Imperial City was constructed in the center of the Old Town in the 13th century. The Gothic extension of the building, with the Reichssaal ("Imperial Hall"), originally intended as a dance hall, was built around 1320/1330.

The Old Town Hall's heyday began in 1663, when it served as the exclusive venue for the Perpetual Imperial Diet's sessions for nearly 150 years. Today, the wheelchair-accessible Tourist Information Office is located on the ground floor. The magnificent Imperial Hall directly above, and the "Fragstatt" former interrogation room in the town hall's basement. can be visited as part of daily tours. Music events and receptions are also held in the Historic Imperial Hall on special occasions. The townhall concerts and Tage Alter Musik festival, which transform the historic space into a concert hall every year in spring/at Pentecost, make for a unique atmosphere. W1 is both an internationally established concert venue for all sectors of young pop culture, subculture and hip culture, as well as a place where young people can create, learn, and try out music. It is in this spirit that W1 regularly holds concerts that bring national and international bands/artists to Regensburg, where they perform concert evenings together with local musicians. The Center for Youth Culture also

provides opportunities for people to hold their own concerts in cooperation with the venue, thereby not only making its stage available to initiatives and cultural associations, but also actively encouraging young people to test out their skills as concert organizers. The music section, with concerts, workshops, and much more, is one of many main focuses of the diverse program that spans the full spectrum of youth culture.

THON-DITTMER-PALAIS

An architectural gem and unique music venue can be found at Haidplatz in the western part of the Old Town. Consisting of several patrician houses, the complex of the modern-day "Thon-Dittmer-Palais", with its classicist façade, provides unique insights into Regensburg's architectural history. The atmosphere and dazzling acoustics of the historic Renaissance interior courtyard make it one of

the finest and most popular event venues in Regensburg. Spanning an area of some 500 square metres, the interior courtyard has a row-seating capacity of up to 400 patrons. The event season generally runs from May to early October, during which time a large stage is set up in the courtyard, available for all organizers to use. The program is very diverse, ranging from classical and modern concerts, to plays and dance performances, to acrobatics and movie nights, meaning there's something for everyone. As twilight falls, the arcade-lined courtyard is bathed in atmospheric light, enabling audiences to enjoy cozy summer nights to the max in a historic setting.

REGENSBURG Theater

Regensburg Theater is not just the largest municipal multidisciplinary venue in Bavaria; it's also a central part of cultural life in Regensburg. Its repertoire spans five disciplines, and music plays an important role in each of them. The concert program consists of Philharmonic Orchestra concerts and chamber-music nights, presented by the Regensburg Philharmonic Orchestra, which also accompanies the music theater productions. Most of the concerts are held in the grand Neuhaussaal at Bismarckplatz. The full spectrum of orchestral works are covered, with a particular focus on contemporary music. Concerts for families and





babies are another unique offering that instilS a love of concerts into the "next generation of patrons" from a young age. The music theater is equally diverse: along with great works from the operatic canon, there are also debut performances, rarely played pieces from more recent music history, chamber operas, and operas for young audiences. Musicals are another permanent fixture of the repertoire.

The drama, dance, and young theater sectors similarly frequently play host to live singing and instrumental music.

Every year, the Haus der Musik plays host to some 100 events and concerts. The "Podium junger Künstler" concert series, for instance, sees the school's students organize concerts. The City of Regensburg annual Music Prize ceremony is also held here, as is the regional "Jugend musiziert" competition. The singing and music school is a cultural establishment in the city of Regensburg. It encourages children,



adolescents, and adults to sing and make music together in the core disciplines of ensemble, choir, and orchestra. In addition to providing support for gifted students and helping prepare for tertiary studies, it also provides basic musical education in all conventional vocal and instrumental subjects.

THURN AND TAXIS PALACE

Between 800 and 1810, St. Emmeram's Benedictine Abbey was an imperial monastery renowned across Europe, with a distinguished library and outstanding collection of music materials. Its treasures, which include one of the most important sources of European music history in the form of the "Codex Aureaus of St. Emmeram," are today stored in Munich. When the secularized monasteryexcluding the basilica-became the residence of the Thurn and Taxis dynasty in 1812, the royal family continued the establishment's cultural tradition. Prince Karl Anselm of Thurn and Taxis (1733-1805) even turned the theater and court chapel into one of Germany's finest complexes. Some 3000 music manuscripts from this time have been preserved in the royal court library. Visitors to St. Emmeram's Palace can visit the

medieval cloister, the crypt chapel, the royal family's grand guarters, the former stables, and the treasury (www.thurnundtaxis.de). The baroque St. Emmeram's Basilica has been a popular concert church since time immemorial, and patrons can experience this side of it for themselves at events such as the annual "Nacht der Musik." In 2003, St. Emmeram's great music tradition was revived by the Thurn und Taxis Schlossfestspielen festival, which sees world-famous rock, pop, and classical-music artists give quest performances in the palace's interior courtyard every July. Viennese magazine "Festspiele" has ranked the event among the "world's best palace festivals." (www.schlossfestspiele-regensburg.de)

It is also one of the most successful. In its approximately 35 years of existence, it has made a name for itself on the international stage, attracting stars and talent from all over the globe to Regensburg. Headline acts like Chet Baker, Archie Shepp, Joe Pass, and Till Brönner have all performed here. But apart from established artists, the jazz club also gets the next generation up on stage, providing a wonderful forum for newcomers and undiscovered talent. GEWERBEPARK REGENSBURG

The Gewerbepark Regensburg has been a renowned event venue for many years. Events such as the Auto Show and Foodtruck Festival attract up to 20,000 visitors to the park every year. And musicians always clearly mark out two important dates in their diary:



The opening of the Bavarian Jazz Weekend and the Piazza Festival, both of which are held at the Gewerbepark's piazza. The Bavarian Jazz Weekend is traditionally opened at the piazza on the Thursday, with primarily international jazz greats get the party off to a swinging start. The Piazza Festival, meanwhile, sees over 10,000 patrons flock to the Gewerbepark every year. A large festival stage is set up at the piazza, with musicians and bands rocking the Gewerbepark for two whole weeks. Yet nowhere makes it easier to get to your favourite musicians' concerts. MUSIC IN CHURCHES

The immense importance of church music is not only demonstrated through the over-1000-year-old tradition of the Regensburger Domspatzen boys' choir, which performs concerts worldwide, but, over the centuries, has also become a major part of both denominations' cultural identities. The many monasteries alone, particularly St. Emmeram's Abbey, were top-class cultural institutions until secularization. The art of Gregorian plainsong is fostered intensively to this day at St. Peter's Cathedral and the Old Chapel. The founding of church choirs in the 19th century also saw a lively folk-music scene develop in the city parishes. The establishment of the Church Music School in



1874 saw Regensburg additionally become one of the most important international training centers for church music. A number of services held in the churches of the Old Town for festive occasions feature elaborate musical repertoires, and concerts are held regularly all year round.

Regensburg's organ scene has also experienced a revival in recent decades as a result of numerous renovations and new constructions. The spectacular, world's largest freely suspended organ in Regensburg Cathedral, the Pope Benedict Organ in the Old Chapel, and the new Bach Organ in the Protestant Holy Trinity Church attract thousands of visitors to the annual organ concert series during the summer months.



UPPER PALATINATE FOLK MUSIC



Until well into the 20th century, folk music was primarily "utility music" consumed for entertainment and, in particular, for dancing. Musicians and melodies would often travel back and forth across Europe. And while there were regional particularities, such as the Zwiefachen-beat-shifting dances that have been classified as Intangible Cultural Heritage since 2016-, most of the repertoire consisted of popular operetta melodies, early hits, or similar.

The efforts to foster folk music in the post-war era have raised public awareness of regional music and traditional instrumentation. But folk music is constantly evolving. In recent years, party bands performing predominantly the latest hits and pop music have once again been joined by folk and brass bands for dancing and singalongs at folk festivals like the Regensburger Dult.

>> Join in: Folk music and pub culture go hand in hand. Experience traditional music at Regensburg's beer gardens and many taverns. Together with the Bayerischer Landesverein für Heimatpflege e.V., other districts, and the DEHO-GA, the Upper Palatinate regional government recognizes musician-friendly pubs that allow musicians to perform in exchange for drinks and snacks. The publicans further support the musicians and singers by having instruments at the ready on site. This gives newcomers in particular the chance to take their homegrown music to the bigger stage. Anyone can give it a go; there's no pre-requisite for being pitch-perfect at all times.



Musicians: The groups on the folkmusic scene are extremely diverse. Many are members of the Oberpfälzer Volksmusikfreunde association, which is active across the Upper Palatinate region with an events calendar, its own CDs and music books, folk-dancing nights, and musician get-togethers. Anyone looking for a group will find it here.

The Oberpfälzer Volksmusikarchiv (OVA), which is part of the cultural and local-history preservation initiative run by the Upper Palatinate government, is the region's musical brains. It's where historic sheet music is stored, reworked, and performed at music events. Sheet music, dance descriptions, and specialist publications are available for borrowing at the library next-door

Regensburg has long been one of the cities with the highest concentration of pubs in Germany. People know each other and help each other out. Often, individual musicians will end up displaying their talent in several bands. This has given rise to a community that is open to new things, that gives things a go, and enjoys an ever-growing fanbase. Regensburg sounds new and exciting.

TAGE ALTER MUSIK

The Tage Alter Musik Regensburg is an international music festival that has been held every year on Pentecost weekend (Fri to Mon) since 1984. It combines historical performance with concerts in historic settings across the city of Regensburg, and is one of the world's biggest

festivals for ancient music, with a repertoire ranging from the Middle Ages to early Romanticism.





CAMPUSFEST

The Regensburg Campusfest is the largest of its kind in Bavaria. It is run by volunteers from the Campus Regensburg e.V. student association, and welcomes up to 10,000 people at the Regensburg campus every year. Over four stages, there's something for every music taste, from indie to



alternative to electro. The Poetry Slam stage, meanwhile, is all about the art of the spoken word. Campusfest is free and open to everyone.





JAHNINSELFEST

The Jahninselfest has become a permanent fixture on Regensburg's cultural and music scene. The predominantly young attendees of the twoday live-music festival particularly love the music, which brings a breath of fresh air to the cathedral city, away from the mainstream. But the cabaret

ORGAN CONCERTS AT REGENSBURG CATHEDRAL

The Bayerisches Jazzweekend is traditionally held on the third weekend of July, spread across a dozen stages all over Regensburg. It always kicks off at the Gewerbepark Regensburg's piazza. Every year, top-class bands and solo artists take up the invitation to celebrate the



Jazzweekend in Regensburg at over 100 concerts. The entire city is pumping over those few festival days. Jazz in the city, a city in jazz!

REGENSBURGER STUMMFILMWOCHE

REGENSBURGER DULT

The Regensburger Dulten, traditional folk festivals, are held two a year—in spring and fall. They treat attendees to a vibrant offering of carnival rides, stalls, beer tents, and great easy-listening



music. In addition to the fun fair, there is also the popular market fair, where merchants from all over the world sell their wares.

PALAZZO-FESTIVAL

The Palazzo Festival is held every year in one of Bavaria's finest arcade-lined Renaissance courtyards at the Thon-Dittmer-Palais. Not only does it boast a magnificent musical program, but it also has outstanding acoustics. Located in the heart of Regensburg's Old

Town, the festival ensures attendees from near and far can enjoy fantastic musical evening entertainment in a great setting.







PIAZZA-FESTIVAL

as other German groups. Both nights also feature tours of the Kunstforum Ostdeutsche Galerie, street art, and culinary delights.

One of the earliest dateable examples of music notation was written in Regensburg around 830. St. Emmeram's Abbey was a leading center for preserving the art of Gregorian chanting.
